

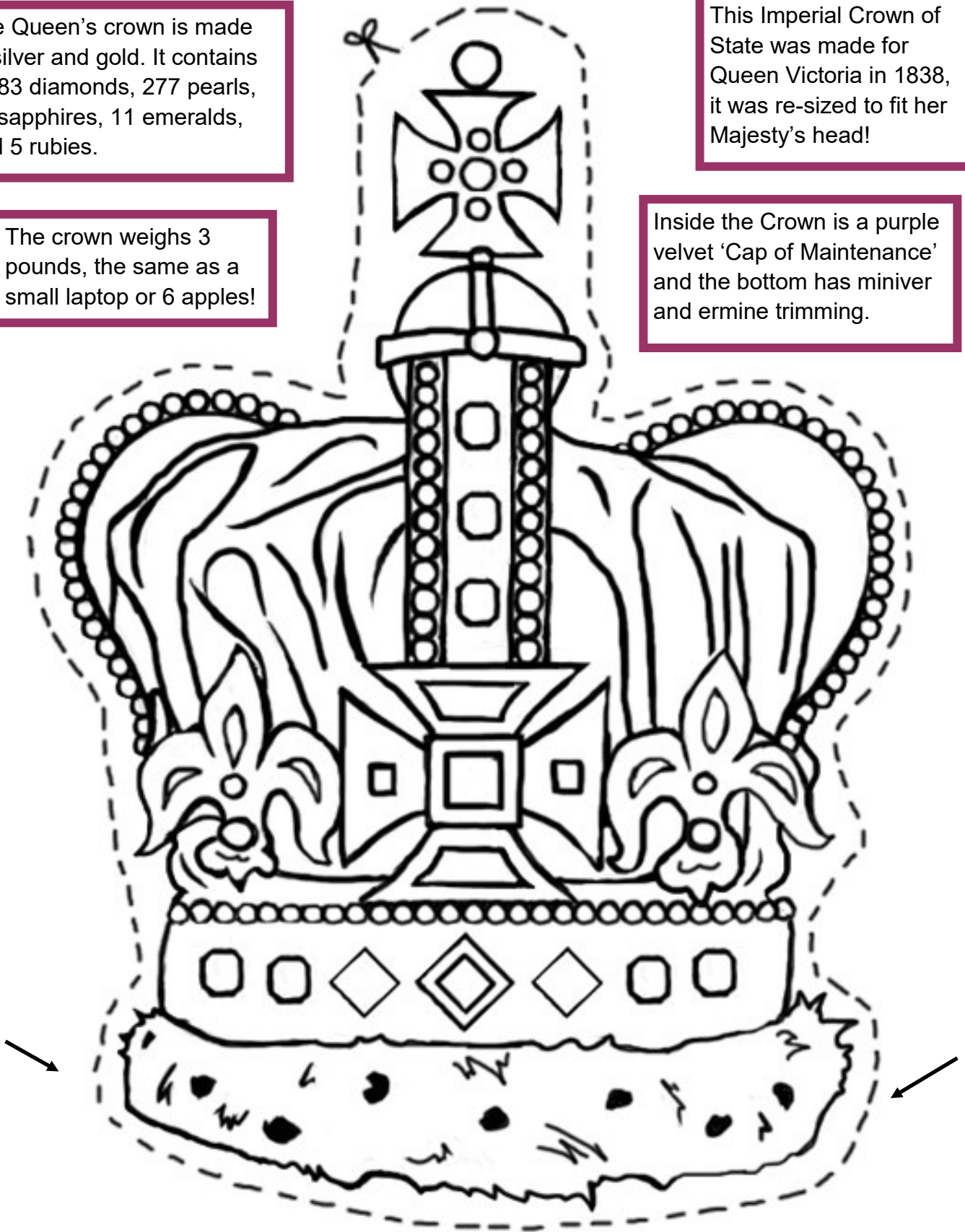
MAKE YOUR OWN CROWN ACTIVITY

The Queen's crown is made of silver and gold. It contains 2,783 diamonds, 277 pearls, 18 sapphires, 11 emeralds, and 5 rubies.

The crown weighs 3 pounds, the same as a small laptop or 6 apples!

This Imperial Crown of State was made for Queen Victoria in 1838, it was re-sized to fit her Majesty's head!

Inside the Crown is a purple velvet 'Cap of Maintenance' and the bottom has miniver and ermine trimming.



STEP 1: Colour in your crown!

STEP 2: Cut out your crown with scissors! You may need an adult to help.

STEP 3: Use a long strip of paper (measured to size of your head) and stick to each side, where you see the arrows.

STEP 4: Enjoy your Jubilee celebrations!



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
